TODAY'S READINGS:

FIRST READING: GEN 32:22-32 PSALM 17:1-7, 16

SECOND READING: ROM 6:3-11

GOSPEL: MT 10:34-42 34 "Do not suppose that I have come to bring peace to the earth. I did not come to bring peace, but a sword. 35 For I have come to turn "a man against his father, a daughter against her mother, a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law-- 36 A man's enemies will be the members of his own household.' 37 "Anyone who loves his father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; anyone who loves his son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; 38 And anyone who does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me. 39 Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. 40 "He who receives you receives me, and he who receives me receives the one who sent me. 41 Anyone who receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet's reward, and anyone who receives a righteous man because he is a righteous man will receive a righteous man's reward. 42 And if anyone gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones because he is my disciple, I tell you the truth, he will certainly not lose his reward." Any way we received the Spirit, it was just as real and just as good as any other. The Lord met us where we were and made his presence known to us in the way we were most ready to experience it. The Spirit blew where she willed, she filled our hearts in whatever measure we were open to the Spirit.

And when it does happen, we know that we did nothing to deserve it. It is God's graciousness lifting us to a new relationship.

Rohr, with his great command of the subject and his ability to write for everyone, gives us these pithy paragraphs. They overflow with encouragement and paint a deeply Christian understanding of the Sender and the instrument of that sending, the Spirit.

From the opening sentence he debunks any "special" or "holy" way of receiving the Holy Spirit. On the contrary, this attentive God meets us as we are and where we are. The Spirit is gracious gift not dependent on anything we can and should do. Open to everyone – God *meets* us in the Spirit. In John's Gospel (Chapter 16) this is the promise of God : that the "Advocate" will come to us. Advocate is someone who draws alongside you, walks with you and, as we understand it, is the discerning whisper of Wisdom open to each of us on our human journey.

Tellingly, Rohr adds : "The Spirit blew where she willed, she filled our hearts in whatever measure we were open to the Spirit". The Spirit will fill us, God will make a home in each of us, but does not take our free will away. This Loving Wisdom, outpouring freely all the gifts, "in whatever measure we are open to receive". The response is ours – to open our hearts, minds and lives, in increasing measure as we learn to trust this invisible Whisper.
